



Sexualized Violence Prevention and Education Facilitator Temporary, Part-time (20 hours/week; 1 year contract)

POSITION SUMMARY

The Kamloops Sexual Assault Counselling Centre (KSACC) is looking to hire a Sexualized Violence Prevention and Education Facilitator. The successful candidate will work directly with the Kamloops Sexual Assault Counselling Centre and with Thompson Rivers University to facilitate and develop promising practices with specific student populations in the areas of consent, responding to disclosures, bystander training and other relevant topics decided upon by the students. As this project/work will be guided by the needs identified by students, the successful candidate will have experience working alongside diverse groups of people. Although this position will be overseen by the Kamloops Sexual Assault Counselling Centre, the successful candidate will be required to actively work with and collaborate with Thompson Rivers University.

The position is considered a temporary, part-time position.

KEY DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

1. Conduct research on current promising practices as related to the project.
2. Conduct a needs assessment to determine the needs of specific student groups.
3. Recruit students from specific student groups to participate in training and workshop design.
4. Facilitate the creation of training and workshops.
5. Help students design a plan to disseminate training within the various student populations.
6. Help students facilitate the training and create mentorship capacity for future training.
7. Conduct evaluation of the training.
8. Create promising practices to guide future training.
9. Perform other related duties as required by the Agency Coordinator.

- Bachelor's degree in a related field
- Minimum 2 years' experience in the area of sexual violence
- Clean criminal record check
- Valid BC Driver's License
